USDA personnel reviewed the Letter of Conditions with the City Commission.

Discussion of proposal from Turnipseed Engineers for the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) and Environmental Report (ER) in connection with the USDA SEARCH Grant

The City Commission agreed to engage City Engineer John McClellan to complete the engineering study in connection with the USDA SEARCH grant.

Hearing- Dennis Williams DBA DA Kitchen Business License Application

- Statement from applicant The applicant addressed the City Commission with his request for a business license.
- Questions/comments from City Commission The City Commission asked Mr.
 Williams several questions about the hours of operation and type of business.
- Public comment There was no public comments.
- Final decision from City Commission The City Commission agreed to issue a provisional business license, including provisions for business closure at midnight.

Williams agreed to the terms. Williams will be issued a letter with the terms of provisional license.

Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whiters

Chief of Police Hank Whiters provided a monthly report to the City Commission.

Discussion of award of FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$289,279.05

Mayor Donaldson announced the City has received another grant to improve the Twin City Fire Department. This grant will equip the new fire truck that should be received later this year. Additionally, the grant will provide new sets of turnout gear for the members of the fire department. Fire Chief Foster Grimes provided the Commission with a summary of the grant. The Commission reviewed a list of the new equipment approved in the grant.

Discussion of Church Street well pump and motor replacement

Mayor Donaldson reviewed quotes for the replacement of the Church Street well pump and motor. The Commission agreed to approve the low bidder of Beasley Well Drilling.

Discussion of T-SPLOST projects band change request

Mayor Donaldson would like to petition to move all the City's T-SPLOST projects to Band 1 from Bands 1 & 3. This would accelerate the resurfacing of W. Broad Street, Old Swainsboro Road, Parrish Pond Road, 1st Avenue, Wilson Road, and Coursey Road.

Discussion of addition of Sandridge Road to 2024 Resurfacing Projects

The City Commission agreed to resurface Rountree Avenue and Ward Street in the June 2024 meeting. With the acceleration of the T-SPLOST projects, Mayor Donaldson would like the Commission to agree to resurface Sandridge Road with this group of projects. Sandridge Road was originally included with the T-SPLOST projects, but it was not included in the final list due to funding shortfalls. All the approved resurfacing projects will be bid together to hopefully encourage more competitive bids.

Discussions of 2023 Audit by City Auditor Keith Waters, CPA

Mayor Donaldson reviewed 2023 audit with the City Commission.

Discussion of City of Twin City Code of Ordinance Recodification

The City Commission was provided a full copy of the draft version of the code. Mayor Donaldson encouraged the Commission to review and report back with any questions.
