CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Donaldson 6:30 P.M.

Presentation from Police Chief Hank Whiters

Chief Whiters gave Mayor and City Commission a monthly report to review. Chief stated that Officer Braswell will graduate from the academy June 18, 2021.

Discussion of potential Jake Brake ordinance from Police Chief Hank Whiters-update from City Attorney George Rountree

The City Attorney said the current City Ordinance code section will cover this violation as written. Section 9-1-3 (6)

Presentation from Fire Chief Foster Grimes on ISO evaluation

Fire Chief Grimes stated there are no updates. We are waiting on results of the evaluation.

Discussion of 2021 CDBG Project and Budget

The City submitting its application for Phase Two of our CDBG projects. This will include replacing all water lines, fire hydrants, and water meters in the project area. The estimated cost is \$1,143,000, with a \$750,000 grant available.

Discussion of April 2021 YTD Expense Summary

As of April 31, 2021, the city had expended 32.21% of the 2021 budget, with 33.33% of the year passed. Mayor Donaldson reported all departments are on budget as of this summary.

Discussion of Georgia Department of Revenue withholding issues from June 2011- December 2015

Mayor Donaldson states that the City is continuing to fix problems we did not create. The City owes roughly \$25,000.00 in back taxes, penalties, and interest. The City is asking for an abatement, and the Georgia DOR has agreed to settle for an amount of \$1,851.00.

Discussion of City Centennial programming

The Memorial Day event was a success. The flags will remain up until July. We are now working on our next event in June. We will have a Groundbreaking Ceremony for the new Centennial Park and Trail on June 18, 2021 at 10AM.
